

2022 Out Wayne CoC Housing Inventory Count

Summary Data Report

The Out Wayne Continuum of Care (CoC) inventoried projects that provide beds and units dedicated to serve persons experiencing homelessness as of January 26, 2022. This housing inventory count (HIC) includes emergency shelter, permanent supportive housing, rapid rehousing, safe haven, and transitional housing projects in the cities of Detroit, Hamtramck, and Highland Park. Each residential project was open for service on the night of January 26th, or was funded and scheduled to begin service within the next year.
